The NICU Journey Bead Program is a family support based program that serves as a connection between parents, their baby, and their healthcare team. It's the ONLY NICU specific bead program and the first of its kind where the focus is on the celebration of milestones,

growth progression, and the parent experience. The program has proven to have an impactful difference, not only for the families but the NICU team as well.

The Journey Bead Program uses special custom hand-made glass beads as a tangible way for parents to record and remember their baby's story. Each handcrafted bead tells a personal story of strength, courage, hope, and healing. This program offers encouragement and inspiration while celebrating and documenting each new step. It's a way to recognize the emotions, remember the milestones, and reflect upon the trials and triumphs that make up a NICU journey.



HOW DOES THE JOURNEY BEAD PROGRAM WORK?

Upon enrollment, parents will receive a special fold-out keepsake bead guide, a leather story line lariat, along with the Signature Footprint Bead to hang at their baby's bedside.

Colorful customized beads, each representing their baby's unique and special story will be given and added to the lariat as their NICU journey continues. Once their baby graduates from the NICU, they will be have a tangible story line full of beads that helps to document and honor their baby's journey through the NICU. Their story will be recorded, and it will be remembered in a very special and meaningful way.

The NICU Bedside Journey Bead program comes inclusive with 20 different glass beads, each representing a milestone. The first bead in the series is a hand-made glass caterpillar and the final graduation bead is a beautiful glass butterfly.

WHY IS THIS PROGRAM SO IMPORTANT?

The Journey Bead Program gives parents an opportunity to document their story and celebrate the milestones all while understanding their baby's needs as they grow and develop in the NICU. The program offers an open dialogue for education and provides an engaging way to connect to the human experience in the NICU. Empowering parents and encouraging them to celebrate their baby's unique story and journey.

WHY BEADS?

Beads have a great history. Dating back 38,000 years, beads have been made from pebbles, shells, teeth, claws, clay, glass and more. The use of beads as a storytelling device is ancient. Pre-literate groups of people all over the world have used visual and tactile clues, such as beads, to help them remember their people's history.

Journey Beads are a way of symbolically representing the stories that are created from everyday moments in the NICU. They become mile markers- or "milestone markers"- for parents and staff to stop, reflect, teach, embrace, and celebrate what would have, in the past, been seen as "just another hurry up and wait" day in the NICU.

Please keep in mind that this program is not jewelry...and not "just beads", but much needed support and education that empowers parents and changes the way they view the NICU experience. Studies show that 60-70% of parents of NICU babies have some symptoms relating to Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). We have to put an end these scary statistics! Peekaboo ICU believes that the NICU Journey Bead Program is doing just that. This program is giving families a tangible way to explore their emotions, recognize them, and acknowledge them. The program brings the human experience to the forefront while providing comprehensive educational support, helping to reduce the negative impact a NICU stay can have on a family. The program not only provides this much needed emotional aspect, but it also helps prepare parents to feel comfortable and confident while caring for their baby. Not only in the hospital, but beyond the walls of the NICU in the years to come.
